
## <u>Investigation #3</u>: My Favorite Dinosaur

## **Materials:**

- Colored pencils
- "My Favorite Dinosaur Table", one per student
- One large sheet of paper
  - o If using construction paper, make sure it is a light color.

## **Procedure:**

- Give each student a copy of "My Favorite Dinosaur Table"
  - o Have them put this sheet into their Journal
- Give each student a large sheet of paper.
- Instruct students to draw and name their own imaginary Dinosaur using as many root words as possible.
- At the bottom of their drawing, list each root word and its meaning.
- Drawings need to be colored.
  - These drawings can be displayed to show their creativity. Ask for volunteers to display their drawings.
    - Note: Do not grade on the "drawings" quality, rather grade on the creativity of the name and how their dinosaur reflects its name.
    - Some students may not want their pictures displayed, you will have plenty to display without theirs.
