Here's an unedited interview with the Maestro himself...

DC: You're alive?

da Vinci: Yeah, weird, right? As I was preparing to take my final breaths, I learned that my birth was a mistake. You can imagine my surprise! Then, five centuries later, I was granted a do-over to test my genius using modern knowledge and technology.
